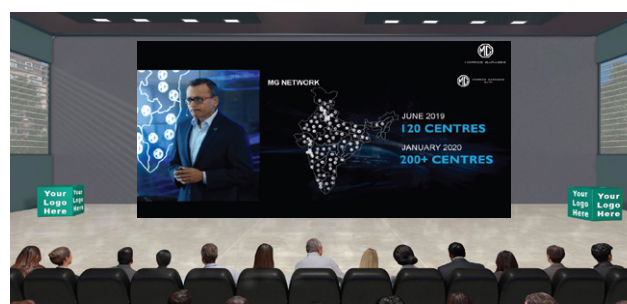


What is a Virtual Conference?
