SYMPOSIUM OVERVIEW

Bone turnover can be assessed non-invasively by the measurement of bone turnover markers (BTM) in the urine and blood. They can be useful in the assessment of all types of metabolic bone disease but in clinical practice their greatest use is in the setting of osteoporosis. The International Osteoporosis Foundation and the European Calcified Tissue Society have advocated bone turnover markers for the identification of non-adherence during treatments with osteoporosis medications, particularly oral bisphosphonate therapy. These are expected to decrease bone turnover markers beyond the least significant change and if not then poor adherence should be suspected. The IOF also recommended the bone turnover markers CTX (for resorption) and PINP (for formation) as the reference marker and these can be measured reliably by immunoassay.

SPEAKER'S PROFILE

He is a Clinical Endocrinology Trust Award Winner. The Professor of Bone Metabolism at the University of Sheffield, Richard Eastell, is the 2020 winner of the Clinical Endocrinology Trust Award. His research focusses on osteoporosis and improving treatment options for patients and he is also Head of the Academic Unit of Bone Metabolism and Director of the Mellanby Centre for Bone Research.
